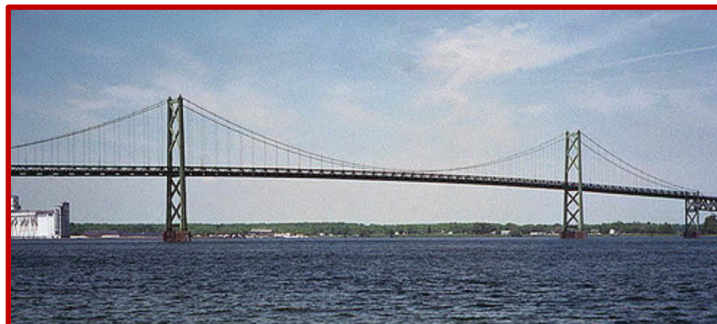

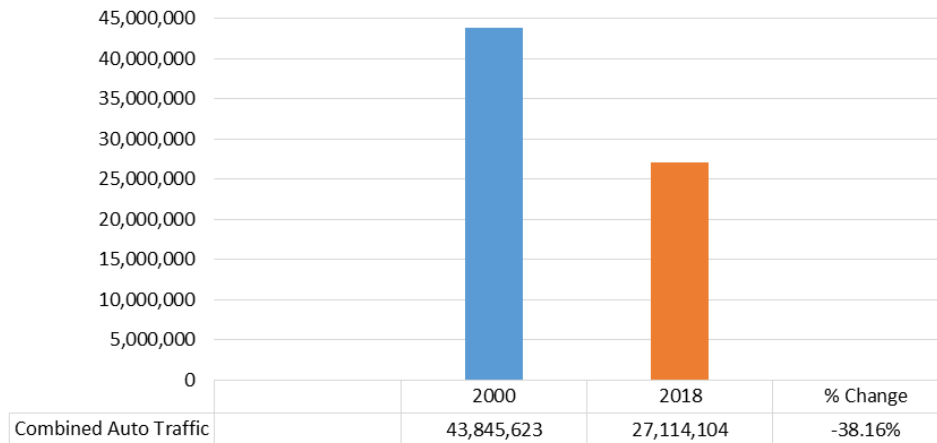

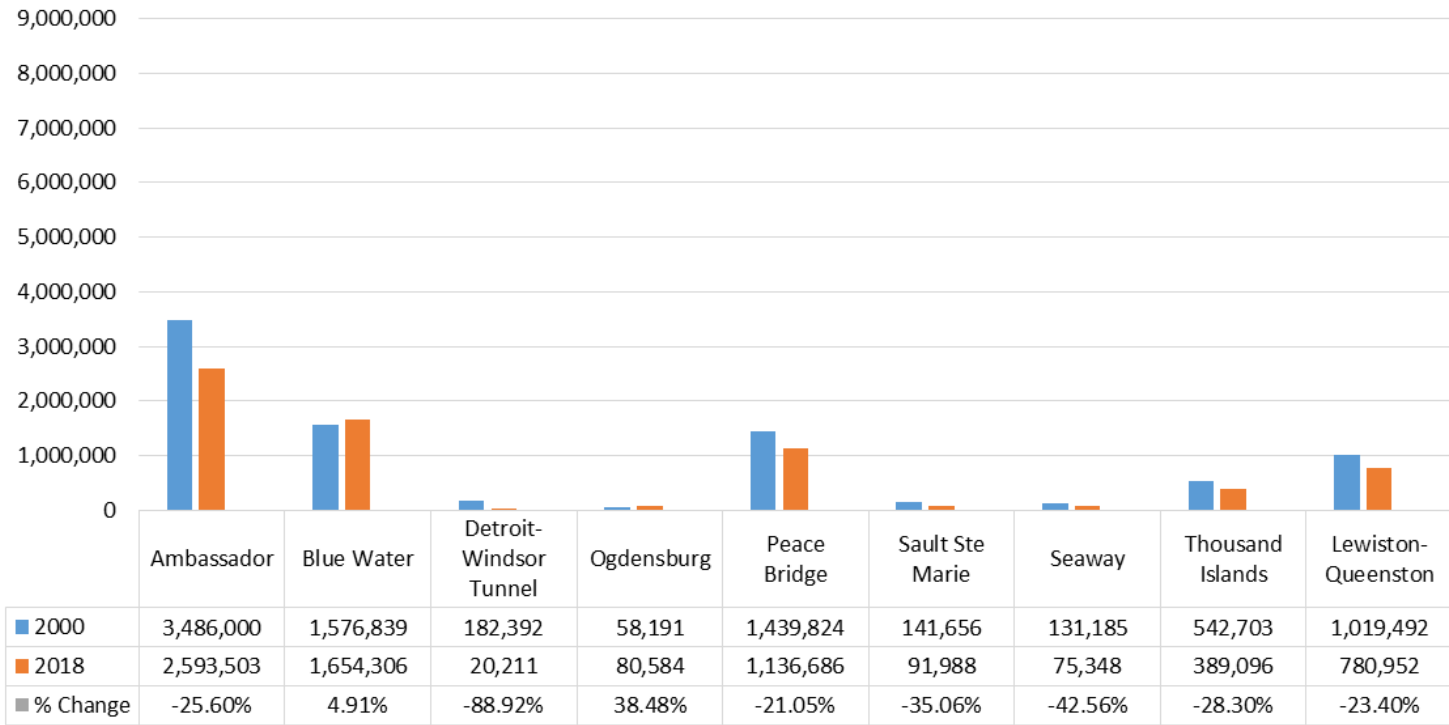
Autos Year 2000 vs 2018



Total BTOA Border Crossings Autos Year 2000 vs 2018

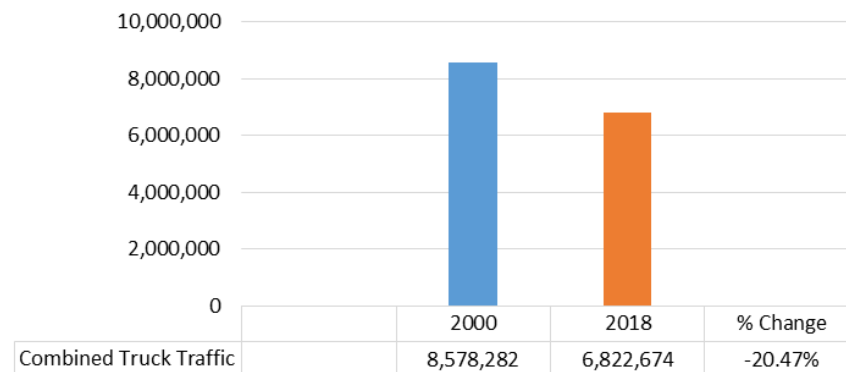


Trucks Year 2000 vs 2018

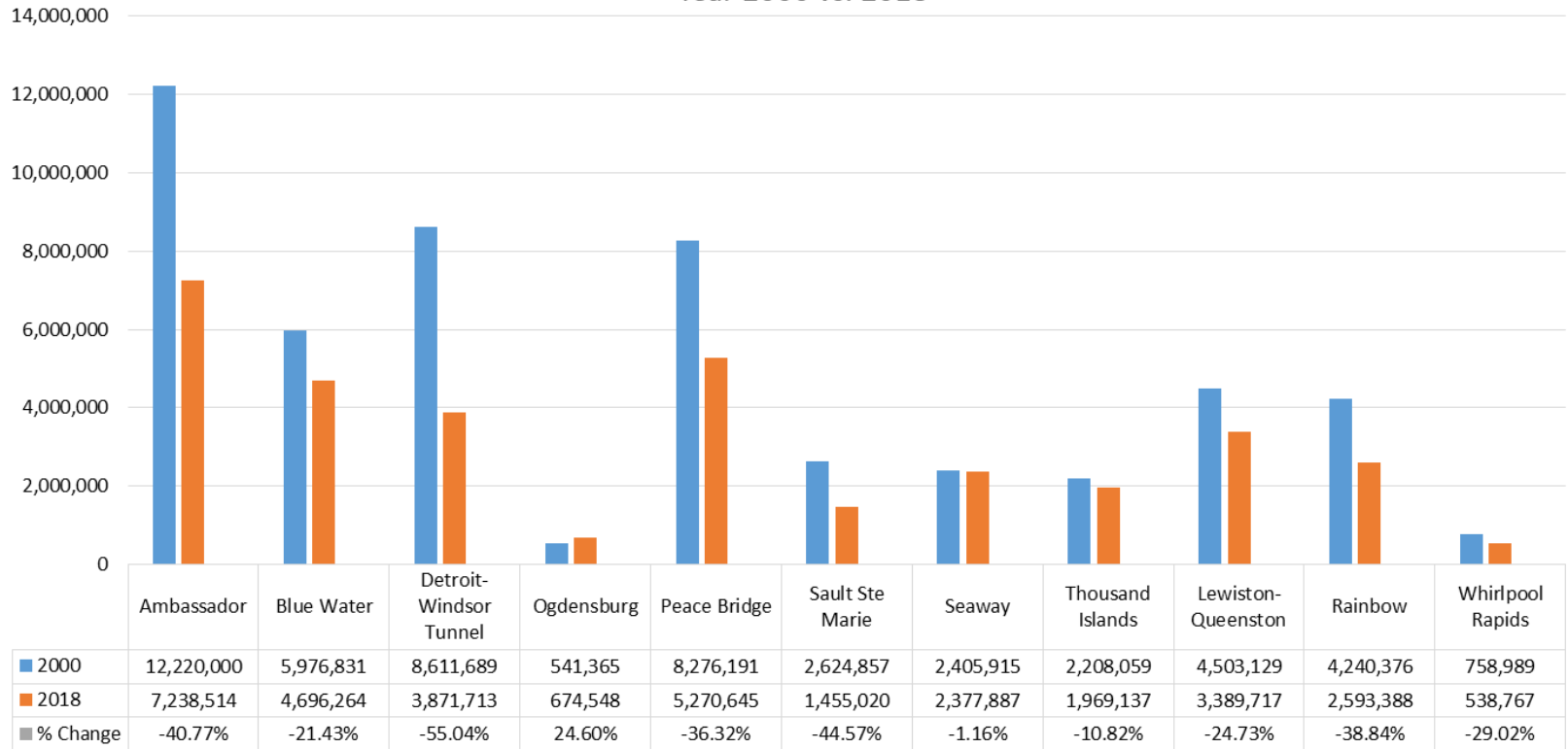
